TASTING PREP-CHECKLIST

Wine, guests...What's next?

Use this checklist as a guide to make your hosting a Big Fat Experience!

- Make sure there is sufficient lighting for the tasting. The lighter the better.**
- Eliminate any extraneous smells or scents. Unplug air fresheners and remind your guests to minimize the use of perfume and colognes. Don't use scented candles.**
- Provide crackers or toasts during the tasting. Once the main tasting event is completed, serve up some good cheeses, fruits, meats and chocolates.**
- White linens and cocktail napkins**
- Choose the right stemware**
- A few corkscrews**
- Spittoons**
- Ice buckets for chilled wines**
- Water**
- Wine tags or charms**
- Local taxi numbers**
